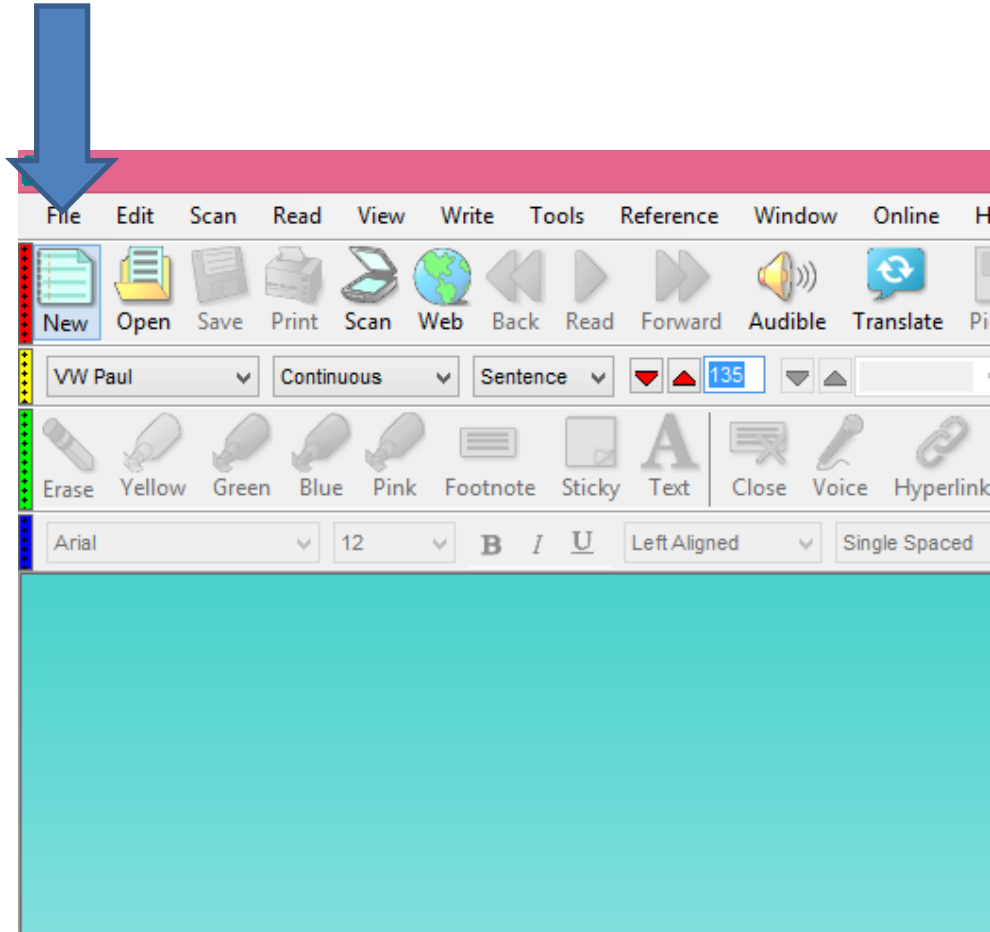

Ways to Get Content into Kurzweil 3000

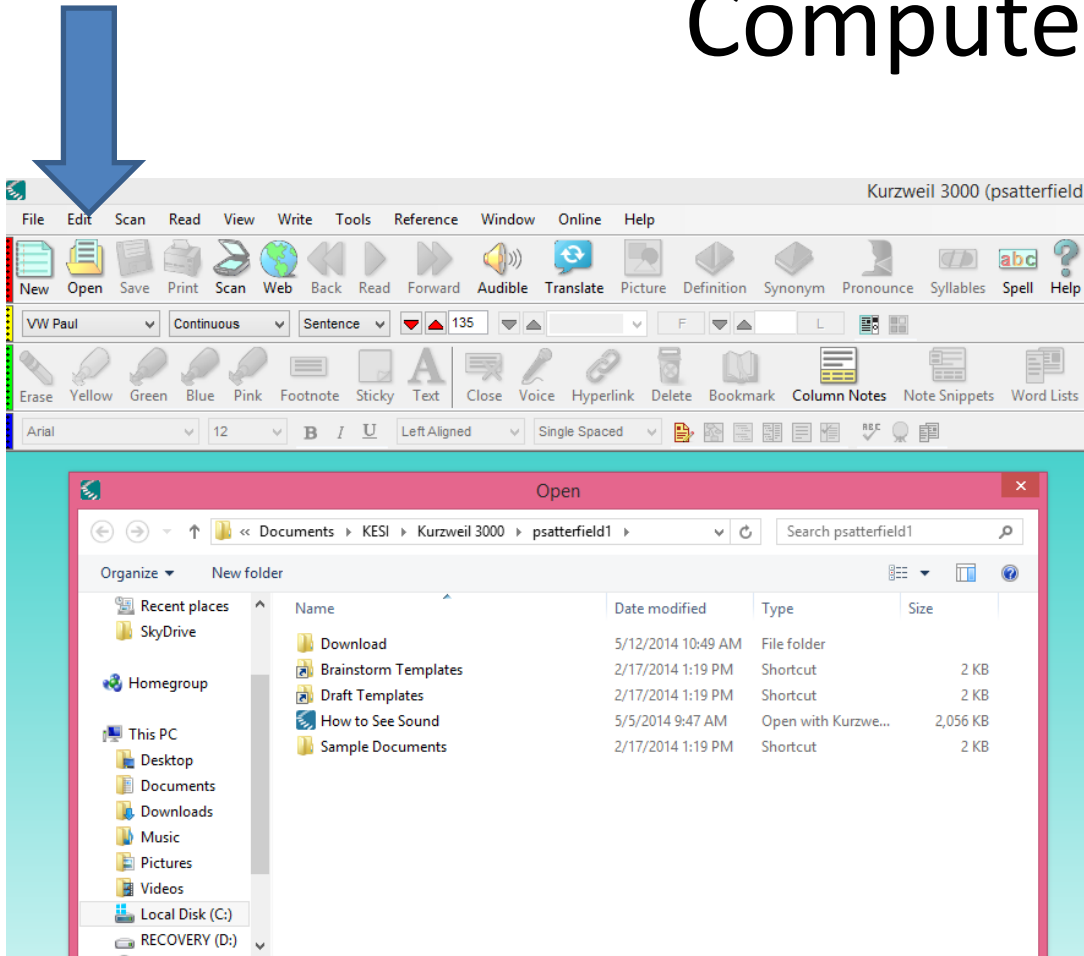
1. Open a new document
2. Open a file from your computer
3. Read on the Web
4. Use the Virtual Printer
5. Open a file from the Universal Library
6. Scan a document into Kurzweil

1. Open a New Document



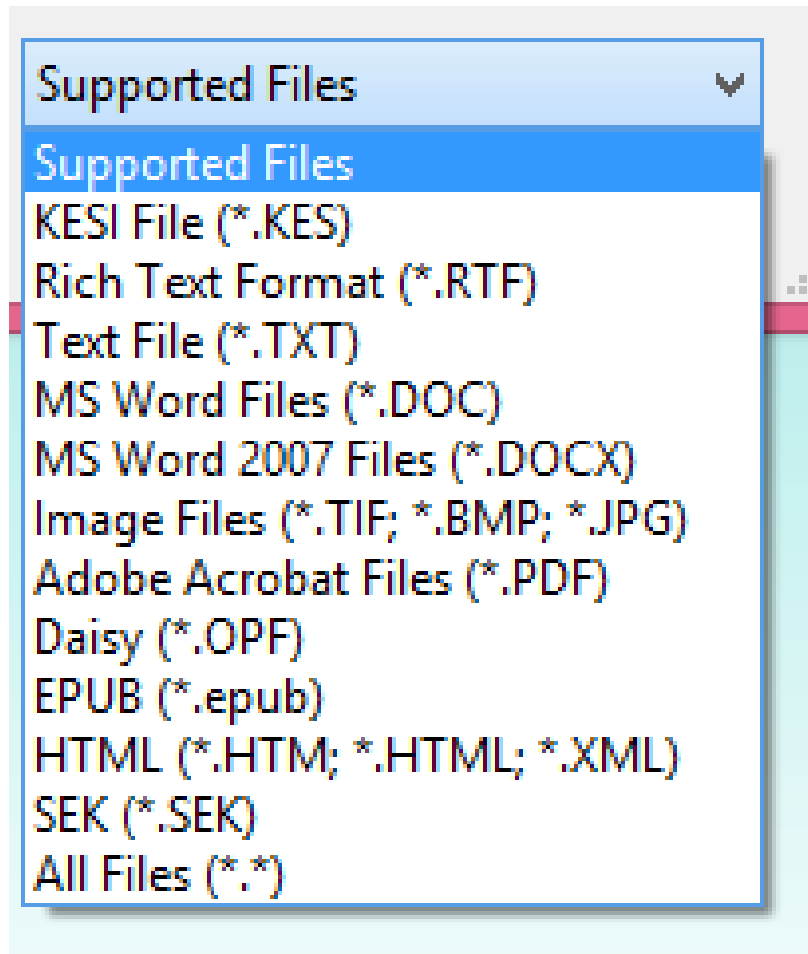
- Click on New on the Main Toolbar
- A new document opens and you can type into it.

2. Open a Document from your Computer



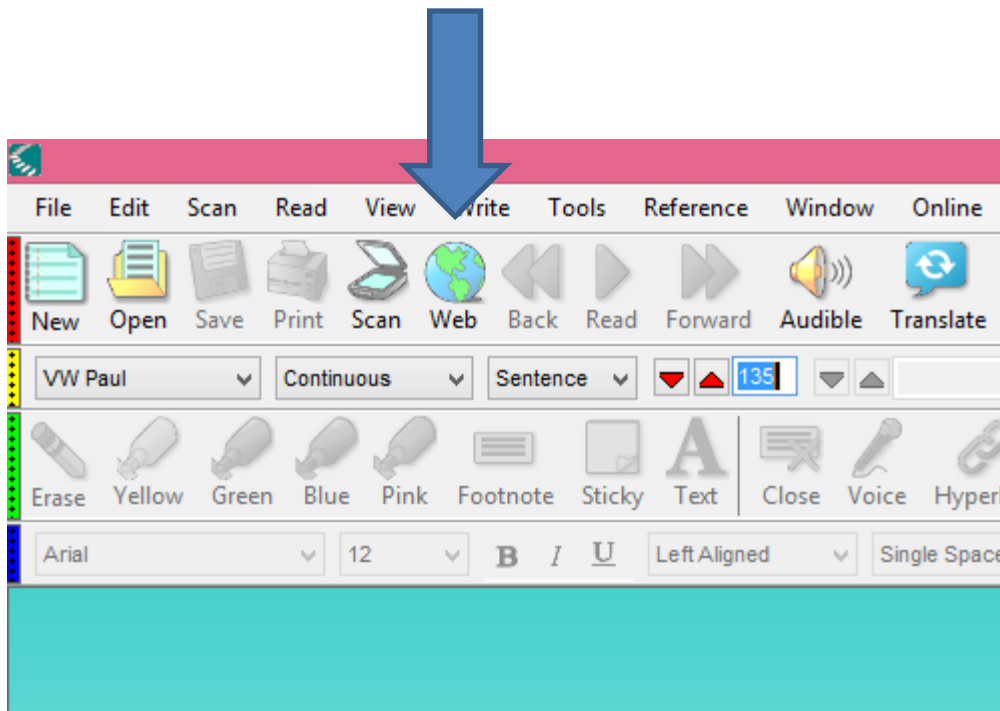
- Click on Open in the Main Toolbar.
- Navigate to the file on your computer.

Supported File Formats





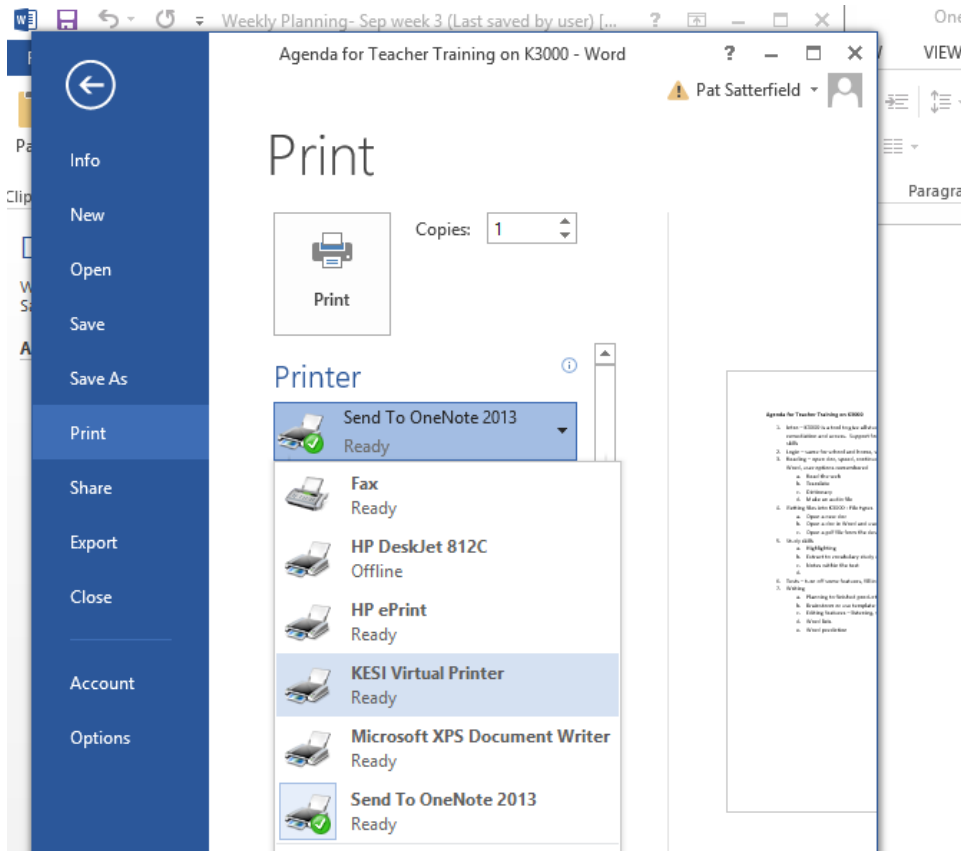

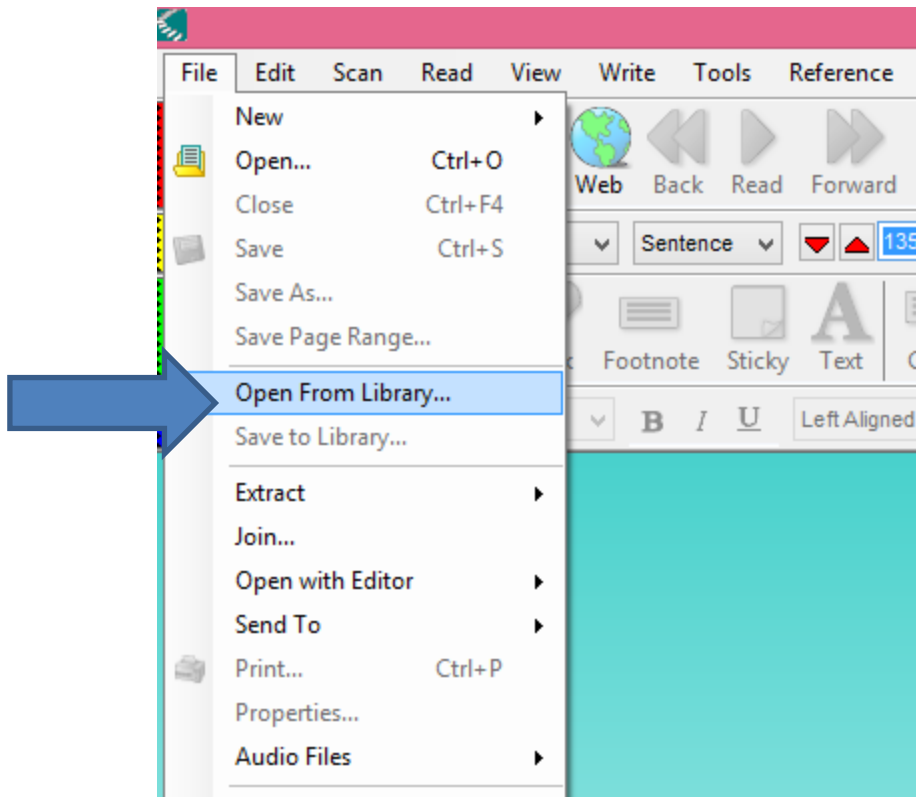

4. Use the Virtual Printer



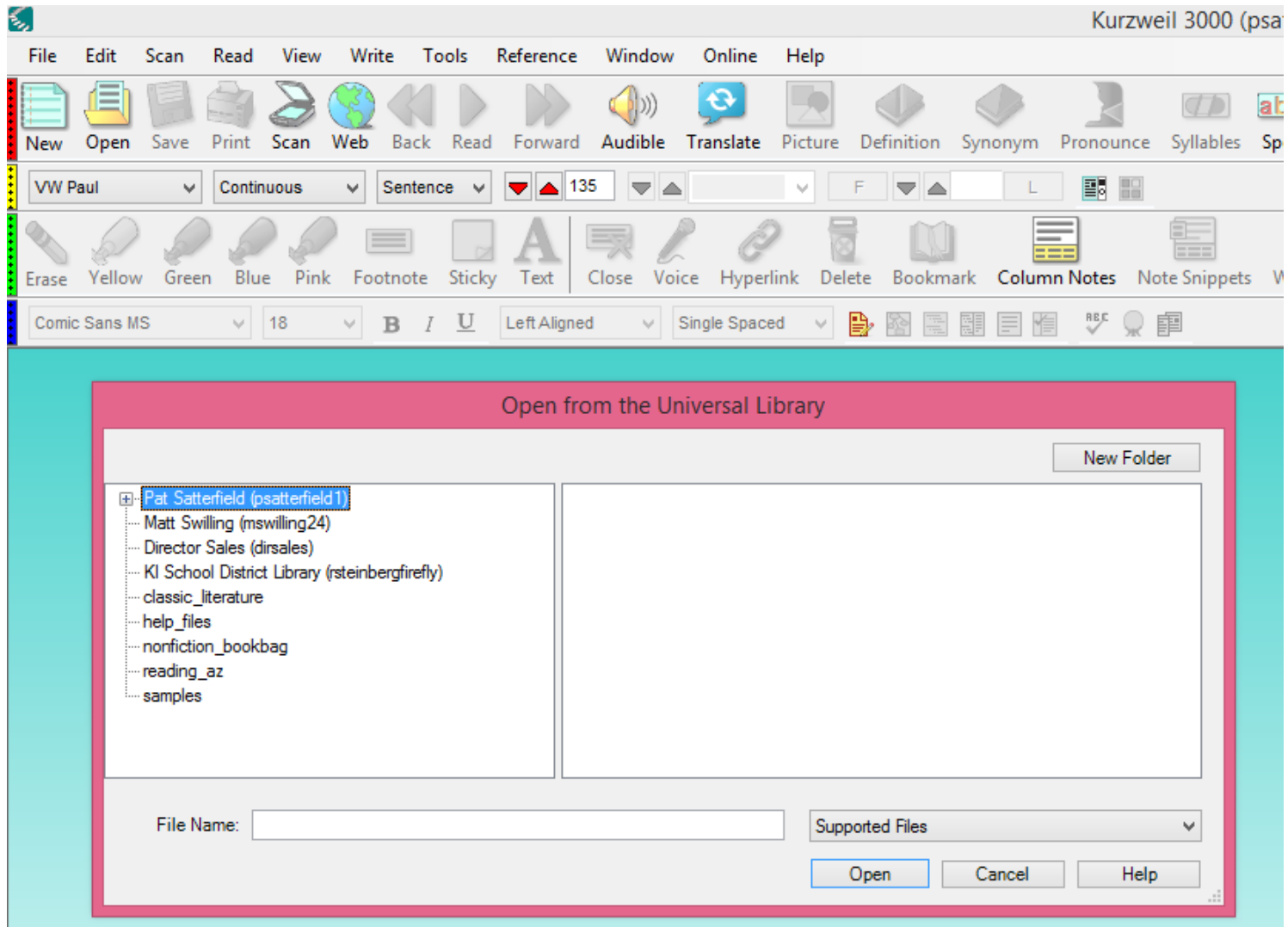
- Kurzweil must be open!

- Read document in K3000!

5. Open from the Universal Library

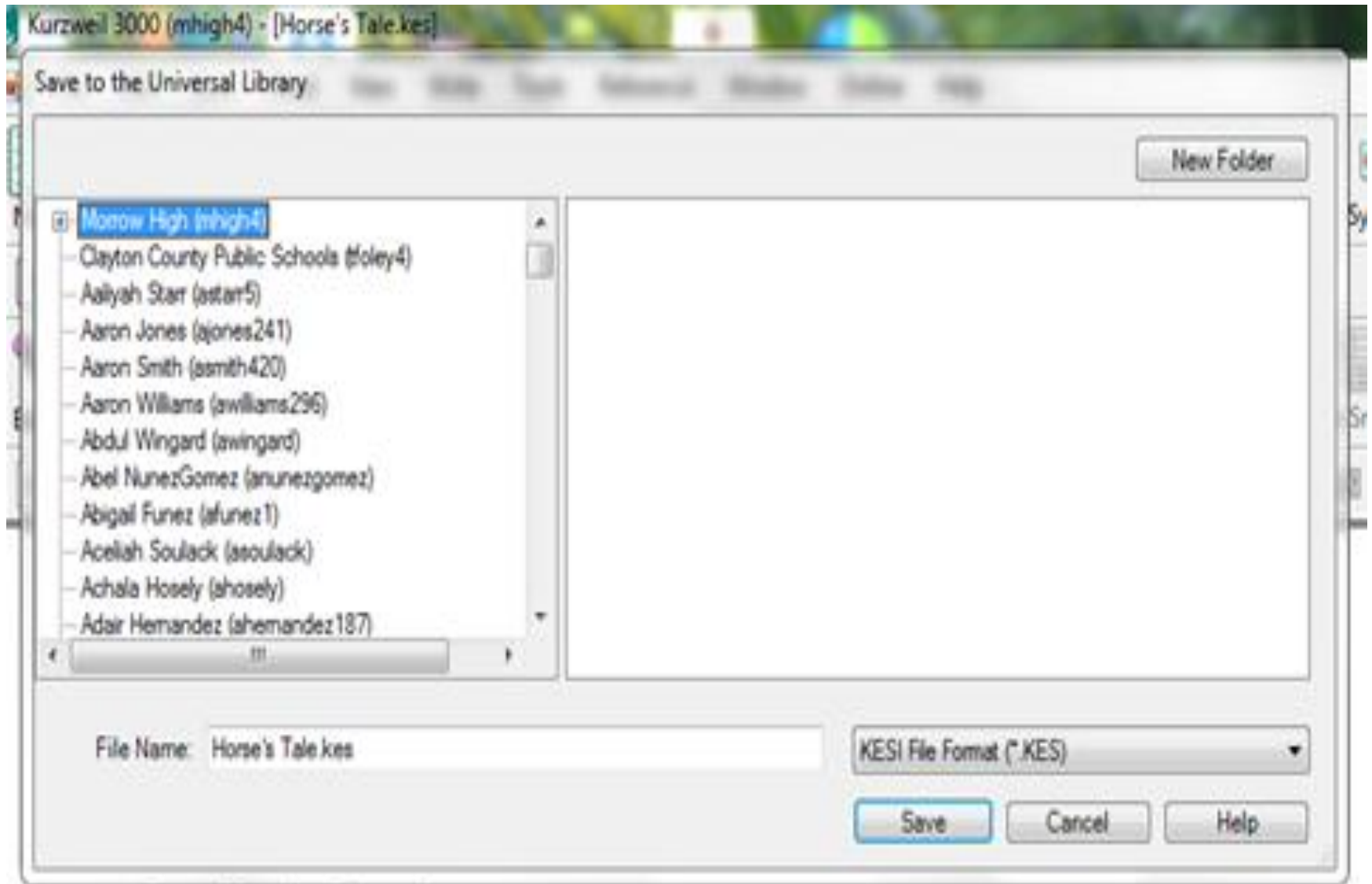


- Instead of “Open”, go to “File”.
- Open from the Library.

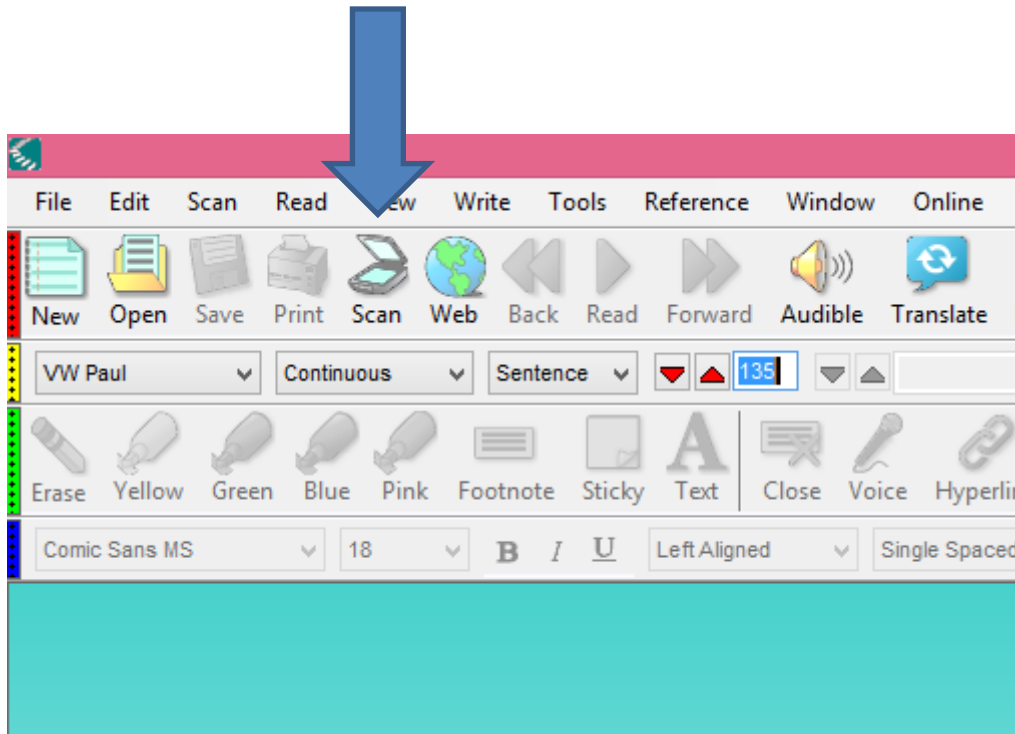
The Universal Library Appears
