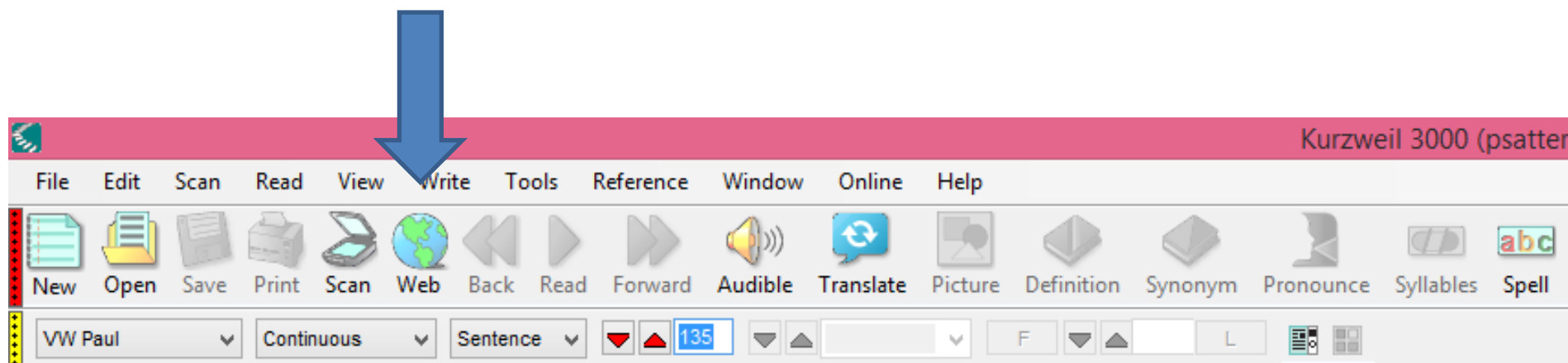

Add Reading Support to On-line Resources

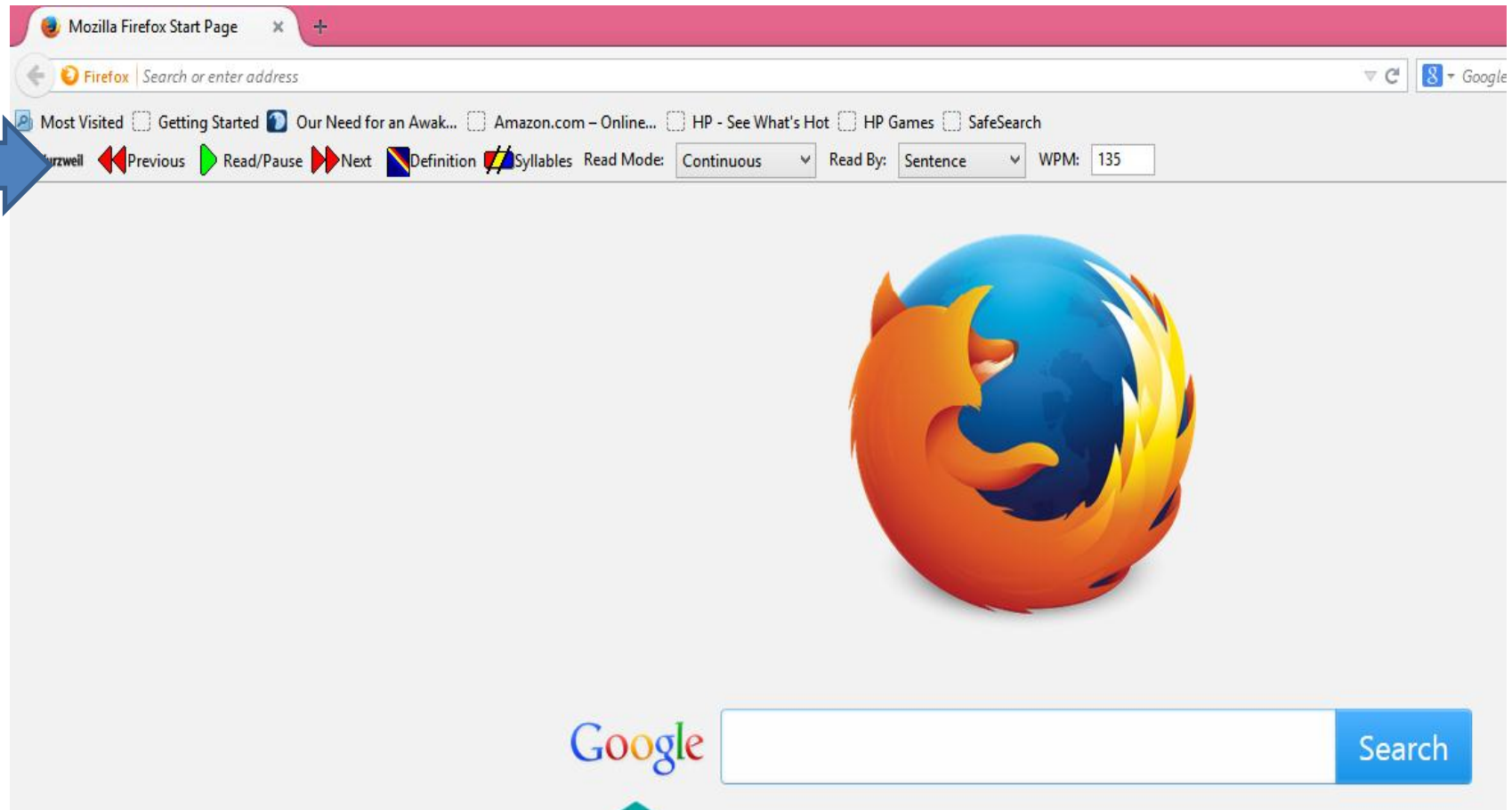
1. Click on the Web icon, read
2. Copy and paste text into a new document
3. Use the Kurzweil Taskbar and Image Reader

Not all websites are created equal...

Some websites do not highlight and read correctly due to their underlying format.

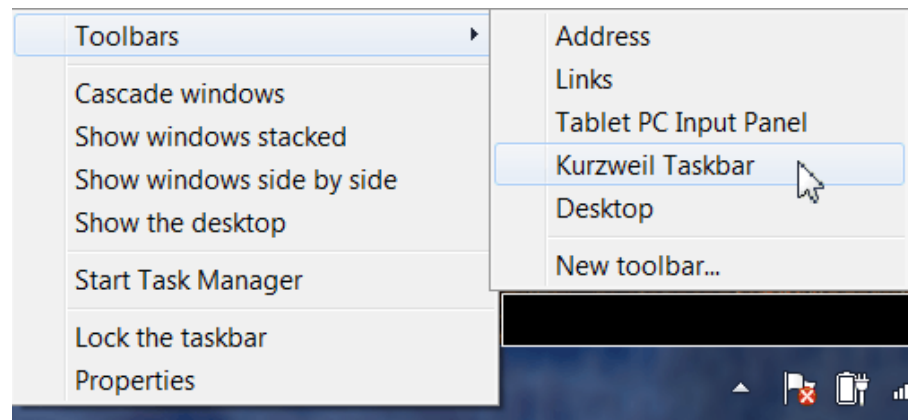
For those websites, we can copy and paste text into a Kurzweil document. Just highlight the text, Copy, then open a New document in Kurzweil, Paste.

OR...

Use the Kurzweil Taskbar

To use the Kurzweil Taskbar, you must have it showing on your computer's taskbar.

Go to the Windows Taskbar. Click the right mouse button. From the Toolbars submenu, select Kurzweil Taskbar.

Why he's here: Obama will be paying an afternoon visit to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to get an update on the agency's fight against Ebola.

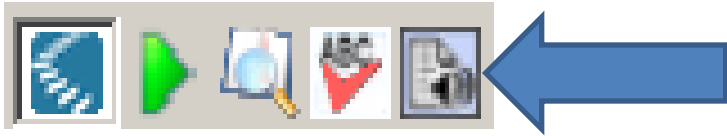
Big announcement expected: The president is expected to announce plans to assign 3,000 U.S. military personnel to regions of West Africa heavily affected by the Ebola outbreak. Obama is also expected to lay out plans to build 17 100-bed health care facilities in the region.

Highlight the text you want to have read, click and drag the whole selection to the Taskbar.

A new window will open and the text will be read aloud.

Use the Image Reader

To read the text associated with a picture, use the Image Reader on the Kurzweil Taskbar.



Click on the Image Reader icon. Use the crosshairs to select the image you want to read. Kurzweil will OCR the picture with the text and read the text to you.
